More specifically, in the affected vehicles, an obstacle in front of the vehicle automatically activates visual park assist. If this feature is first automatically activated, and the reverse gear is then engaged within a very short time interval, the rearview camera may not activate within the required response

time.

FMVSS 1: 111 - Rear visibility

Description of the Safety Risk: Under the described circumstances, only the visual park assist is displayed

and the rearview camera is not activated. This could increase the risk of an

Chronology:

In August 2024, Porsche was informed about a potential malfunction of the rearview camera in a certain use case which happened during a function endurance test.

In the further course, it was analyzed whether the use case is reproducible and can even occur in field vehicles. In addition, the affected markets had to be analyzed from a regulatory point of view as well as the subject vehicles had to be identified.

On September 25, 2024, Porsche determined a non-compliance with FMVSS 111 and decided to recall the affected vehicle population.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: To ensure that the rearview camera is activated correctly, the central computer must be programmed with the updated data set.

> In addition, further software optimizations for various control units are available for the Taycan. As part of this campaign, the control units will be reprogrammed with the PIWIS tester to the current VR11.1 software
