### Affidavit for Arrest Warrant

The undersigned Affiant, A. Jackson #2593, being a Peace Officer under the laws of the State of Texas and being duly sworn, on oath, makes the following statements and accusations:

- A victim in this case has been identified as Turning Point USA, hereinafter referred to as the Victim.
- An actor in this case has been identified as Jacob Wenske, date of birth February 09, 2000, hereinafter referred to as the Defendant. Said Defendant is further identified in SAPD computer files under SID #
- It is the belief of your Affiant that the offense of  
TERR THREAT IMP PUB SERV/PUB FEAR SBI/INFLU GV  
was committed on or about the 12th day of April, 2026, in Bexar County, Texas.
- Your Affiant has probable cause for said belief by reason of the following facts:  
Your Affiant is a Detective currently assigned to the San Antonio Police Departments Fusion Center. I am assigned as the lead investigator on SAPD26106466.

Your Affiant has reason to believe and does believe the Defendant committed the offense of Terroristic Threat in violation of Texas Penal Code §22.07. Your Affiant has reviewed open-source social media evidence, prior investigative reporting, preserved Facebook communications, and associated records related to threatening statements made by the Defendant concerning the Victim, the Victim's-affiliated events, and supporters associated with those organizations.

On or about April 12, 2026, the San Antonio Express-News published a Facebook post promoting the Victim's Women's Leadership Summit scheduled to occur at the listed location located on the River Walk in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

The post referenced Erika Kirk visiting San Antonio in connection with the event. Your Affiant reviewed the public Facebook comment thread associated with that post and identified comments attributable to the Defendant. Within the thread, the Defendant posted the statement, "I know exactly where to bomb." This comment constitutes a threat to commit violence involving explosive force capable of causing death, serious bodily injury, and widespread public danger.

The Defendant later posted an additional statement within the same event-related thread stating, "I can't wait to be the valet for her escort."

Your Affiant knows through training and experience that bombing references directed toward identifiable public events, venues, or public figures constitute significant indicators of targeted violence and are commonly interpreted as threats of mass-casualty violence. Your Affiant further knows that references to escort, valet, or

movement-interface environments surrounding a public figure may indicate surveillance, proximity-seeking behavior, or operational interest in event access points.

The event referenced in the Defendant's comments is scheduled to occur on June 5, 2026 through June 7, 2026, making the Defendant's bombing-related statements imminent and directly connected to an upcoming public gathering at an identifiable San Antonio venue. Your Affiant believes the timing of the statements materially increased the reasonable fear of serious bodily injury or death among event attendees, organizers, hotel personnel, and members of the public.

Your Affiant additionally reviewed prior communications attributable to the Defendant, including an email sent on or about January 26, 2026, utilizing a known registered email account associated with the Defendant. In that communication, the Defendant stated in substance, "Death to Erika Kirk and every single speaker there!! America will live on without those scum on this earth. Every Christian nationalist shall perish in the bombing that will take place at every single Turning Point rally and event."

Your Affiant knows through training and experience that the above communication contains explicit death threats, references to bombings targeting multiple Victim's events, organization-wide targeting language, and ideologically motivated violent rhetoric. Your Affiant believes the Defendant's conduct demonstrates more than generalized political disagreement or protected hyperbolic speech. The Defendant repeatedly engaged in threatening and violent rhetoric directed toward identifiable persons, organizations, and public event environments, including explicit bombing references tied to a known venue and event occurring within Bexar County, Texas.

The above investigation revealed the Facebook profile used to post the threatening comments utilizing the Defendant's profile was controlled and utilized by the Defendant. Account attribution was established through associated subscriber records, including a registered email address, linked telephone number, and IP address information associated with the Defendant.

Your Affiant believes the Defendant intentionally and knowingly threatened to commit violence with the intent to place the Victim, members of the public, event attendees, venue personnel, and the Victim's affiliated individuals in fear of serious bodily injury and to influence or disrupt the use of a public place and public event, namely the Turning Point Women's Leadership Summit at the San Antonio Marriott Rivercenter by threatening to commit violence through the statement, 'I know exactly where to bomb.'

The Defendant additionally referenced proximity to the event environment by stating, 'I can't wait to be the valet for her escort. Your Affiant knows through training and experience that bombing threats directed toward identifiable public gatherings, hotels, political events, or high-visibility venues commonly create fear of imminent serious bodily injury or death among attendees, staff, organizers, security personnel, and members of the public.

The Investigation revealed the Defendant previously worked for a parking management company providing valet services to hotels and special events. Your Affiant believes this information is relevant because the Defendant's prior experience with valet operations provides contextual significance to his statement referencing being 'the valet for her escort' in connection with the identified event venue. Your Affiant further believes the Defendant's statements were reasonably calculated to place the public or a substantial group of the public in fear of serious bodily injury and to disrupt or influence the use and operation of a public place and public event. The Defendant's conduct was not isolated or ambiguous.

Your Affiant reviewed additional Facebook comments attributable to the Defendant showing ongoing violent hostility toward Turning Point-affiliated persons and supporters, including death-approval statements, encouragement of harm toward ideological opponents, and repeated hostile engagement across multiple public threads.

Your Affiant additionally reviewed a prior January 26, 2026 communication attributable to the Defendant in which the Defendant threatened bombings at 'every single Turning Point rally and event' and threatened

death toward Erika Kirk and associated speakers which he directly communicated to TPUSA.

The Defendant's threats resulted in a substantial alteration of security operations surrounding the event, including the deployment of additional uniformed officers, explosive-detection K9 resources, increased private security staffing, and heightened protective measures, causing operational disruption and significant monetary expense to the victim venue."

Based on the totality of circumstances, Your Affiant believes the Defendant intentionally and knowingly threatened violence in a manner intended to place the public and event participants in fear of serious bodily injury or death, constituting the offense of Terroristic Threat under Texas Penal Code §22.07.



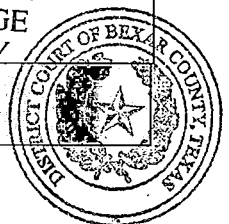
